EDO Report, Keith Collier

- Overview of the last year
- Training Programs: Drillers Course, Work Readiness Program, 1st Welders Trade Readiness Program, Class 3 Training Course. These course were successful and went well.
- Tourism Development Project update
- Tourism in the coming year:
- The original 5 year funding program is ending March 31st, 2014. We're pursuing other funding options to keep our tourism officer for another couple years. There will also be funds for marketing, programing and other things for tourism development.
- Looking for more training opportunities for this year: welding program in the fall and more work readiness and driving programs.
- I have the Economic Development Plan if any councillor would like to review it

Councillor Caskey:

Soapstone discussion: We had bought soapstone in the previous year, do we have enough today or should we find another source to get the soapstone?

EDO, Keith Collier: Working with ED&T in finding a good source for soapstone

Councillor Caskey:

Suggests to consider another source for soapstone as the shipping season is coming soon.

EDO, Keith Collier: Right now, we have some soapstone available for carvers to buy at \$1/lb. We have already decreased the price, but we have not sold very much.

Councillor Anoe Jr.:

Suggests to re-advertise the soapstone that we currently have by radio, facebook and public posts.

Councillor Caskey:

In other communities, the Nunavut Arctic College is doing a variety of courses. In Arviat, the Hamlet is doing the mine drilling courses, welding and other courses as well. Does NAC contribute any funds towards this?

Mayor, Bob Leonard:

The Nunavut Arctic College doesn't have funding for courses. If someone will pay for a course, they'll put it on. They have very few courses that they're core funded, most that need a sponsor.
