 - Says the Niqitaarvik society has been receiving funding to give out food hampers.
 - Says the Arviat Fund has been giving the Niqitaarvik society funding to provide food hampers and warm meals to those in need.

 - Says the airport radio operator is the only one working at the airport.
 - Suggested to write a letter to Nunavut airports to request to open a 2nd airport radio communicator position as there have been times when the cargo plane and medivac came in with no one at the communications tower.
 - Says it would be more viable to get a 2nd airport communications personnel.

 - Says he will write a letter to Nunavut Airports to request to open 2nd communications personnel who can work full time.
