Mayor Leonard: Other than newspaper announcement about the facility, no other news yet. KIA wanted to go to all 7 communities about this project and also plans for the building will take months to complete. This is not happening this year.

Nathan Caskey: MLA George Kuksuk mentioned the CLEY funding that promotes traditional skills and language, we could apply for some of this funding to use for our programs such as: igloo building for students.

Mayor Leonard: We can take this opportunity to the recreation committee and bring it up for them to enquire about.

Nathan Caskey: To fix up our land assembly, are we going to contract this out, and if so, it's going to be costly in regards to equipment and staffing as it is a long ways to reach the destination.

SAO Steve: We are going to contract that project and have taken into consideration all factors, pricing and staffing to complete it.

Nathan Caskey: Asked the Council if they agree to have the Hamlet Council previous minutes and the agenda be posted publicly. Post on the bulletin board about the Hamlet website for viewing the published minutes. Put up a bulletin board to post these announcements to keep the public informed.

• Jamie Kablutsiak: Would like to thank the successful efforts of the Search and Rescue team, along with the Hamlet Council staff and board, the RCMP and the volunteers who helped in this difficult time. Also enquired about the Dionne Lake pump house; any news about it yet. Understood from last year's meetings that it would be pumped from Dionne Lake instead of Wolf Creek. Has there been any changes of the plans since it was brought up. Enquired about purchasing a dozer, either rebuilt or almost new, if possible.

SAO Steve: The Hamlet had just purchase a new grader this year along with a new 650 Cat. Soon as we can afford to purchase again; we are looking at a D6 tractor or D8 tractor. We have to be careful with our debts as we just purchased the grader.

Mayor Leonard: This subject has been talked in the long term projects, such as the utilidor system, and will continue to aim for it. The safety quality of water is also being looked at, as well as the drop in the creek when the weather changes, the snow melts and the creek decreases in time.

Jamie Kablutsiak: Enquired if we are planning to purchase or build a garage in the next 5 years or more.

SAO Steve: No plans for new garage as of yet. But currently working with Nunavut Airports about paying rent towards the garage space, free up our Hamlet space in the garages or buy one for themselves. A request was put into the ICSP review but it looks like it's not going to happen soon.

• Elizabeth U Issakiark: Hearing on the radio and local cb, been hearing penny sales/ fundraising events that people are now holding: Do they need a license to do this. Sometimes radio station is used for penny sales, with upfront payment of \$20 to pay for the lobby. Radio Station pays a huge amount of rental to Lumber Supply for the building. This isn't fair to those who pay in full.
