3. Water Reservoir (Attached document)

CG&S presented the situation on the water reservoir and the various options that are being considered. One option being considered is the purchase of a 40Kw genset to be used as a power source for a sump pump that would be housed in a temporary structure that could be built and placed at an approved water source. Landing Lake and Fire Lake are two sources that are currently being considered and water samples have been collected and submitted for analysis. A more direct road to these lakes will be considered and evaluated as the current access will be difficult to maintain. Discussion around using local contractors to build an alternative road and maintain on an as and when needed basis was discussed as the Hamlets 1st priority is to maintain roads within the Hamlet.

A desalination plant has been rejected as not being economically feasible.

Questions and comments followed with input from the Hamlet Council. CG&S have offered to provide a contribution agreement to the Hamlet from now until March 31st 2011 in the amount of \$45,000.00 to offset any additional operating costs that the Hamlet incurs as a result of the reservoir situation.
