Deputy Mayor Anoe:

- Opening/schedule of community freezer
SAO: In the process, the attendant should start beginning of June.
- S&R Chairman has been doing a good job notifying the public especially Spots.

Councillor Caskey:

- Night guard – will there be a contract anytime soon.
SAO: Yes, there will be a proposal going out in the next week or so.
- By-law officers, in the past they wore uniforms and worked with the police? Maybe the hamlet can add another by-law officer.
SAO: There is only one by-law officer and the other is a dog catcher. One of the officers is trying to take a year of absence. I will take a job description for the by-law officer out.
- Do they have a dedicated phone number?
SAO: Yes, they do.
- For the fishing derby, wasn't there a policy for school/working day?
SAO: There is no written policy, in the past there was, but nothing was ever written
- Instead of our policies being unwritten, we should have them written and signed.

SAO: yes, we will work on that.

Councillor Savikataaq:

- By-laws – are they going to be digitized?
SAO: there will be summer students who will be doing that.
- Power poles at 208-3rd avenue. Was there a letter or notification sent?
SAO: A follow-up letter will be sent.
- It's the perfect time right now to measure the water at the water reservoir
SAO: the reservoir was measured. It was about 8-9 feet, may be needing to fill soon.
- For tenders, what is the process?
SAO: explains the process that the hamlet uses.
- I know it is a bit late but, I believe that the late Peter Suwaksiork should be recognized with an award for all the work he has done for Arviat.
- Thanks Tommy Owljoot for getting a singer to come to Arviat this June.

Councillor Shamee:

- Received a call from a lady complaining about intoxicated people at the teen dances.
Mayor: whoever is holding the dance is responsible for having/hiring security guards.

Councillor Tattuinee:

- Loss of another teacher this year totaling 13.5 positions in two years.

Councillor Komakjuak:

- LRP sea can was broken into resulting in bikes stolen.
- Water and sewage complaint: did not receive water for four days.
SAO: casual weekend drivers are sometimes not as fast as the regular drivers.

Mayor:
